

NORTH & SOUTH SHROPSHIRE HUNT SCURRY 2017

EASTER MONDAY 2nd APRIL 2018

NB: THE SCURRY IS NOT RUN UNDER BHA REGULATIONS

The North & South Shropshire Hunt Scurry is a wonderful opportunity for all budding jockeys to ride the renowned Eyton on Severn Point to Point course. The scurry will cover approximately 1.5 miles over 7 fences and will take place after the last race at 4:45pm. Non Cash Prizes will be awarded for the following categories:

1. Closest to optimum time (Thoroughbred)
2. Closest to optimum time (Non Thoroughbred)

Optimum time being a good hunting pace!

RULES & REGULATIONS

RIDERS

1. All competitors enter the scurry entirely at their own risk
2. Must be aged 16 or over on the day of the scurry
3. Must not hold a current point to point certificate or licence to ride under National Hunt rules
4. Must have personal insurance to take part in the scurry
5. Either hunt dress or cross country colours
6. Safety Crash Helmets to current British or European Safety Standards must be worn by all participants with British Standard PAS 015, 1384 or European equivalent
7. Body Protectors must be worn labelled Level 3 in the year 2000 or after, air jackets may be worn but must be worn with a compliant body protector
8. All participants must walk the course and attend pre scurry briefing
9. Riders must not remount after a fall
10. Riders must obey the Starter's orders and the Judge's decision is final

HORSES

1. Horses must be 5 years and over and not over 18 years
2. Must not currently be qualified to run under either the Rules of Racing or the Point-to-Point Regulations
3. Horses passports must be available on the day for inspection if required
4. Must have up to date vaccinations for equine flu
5. No studs or equivalent permitted
6. Hunting or racing tack acceptable, this will be inspected by a paddock steward pre scurry
7. A number cloth will be provided on the day upon declaration which must be returned

FURTHER INFORMATION

1. The scurry will take place at 4:45pm after the last point to point race on the card
2. The scurry is not a race therefore prizes given to the closest Optimum Time – set at a good hunting pace, this is a ride not a race!
3. Betting on the scurry is strictly prohibited
4. Declaration on the day must be made before 2:30pm to the declaration tent
5. In the event that the Scurry is cancelled participants will be informed via the e-mail address they have provided
6. Entries will be taken on a first come basis with a maximum of 10 runners
7. Acceptance or refusal of entry will be at the discretion of the organisers
8. Horses and riders to both be fit and competent to take part, the organisers and stewards reserve the right to ask any participant not to take part or to stop during the scurry if any horse or rider considered unfit to continue for any reason
